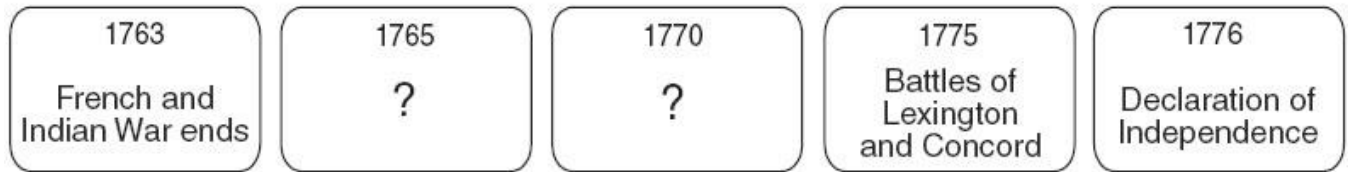


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1. Which events in U.S. history best complete the time line above?

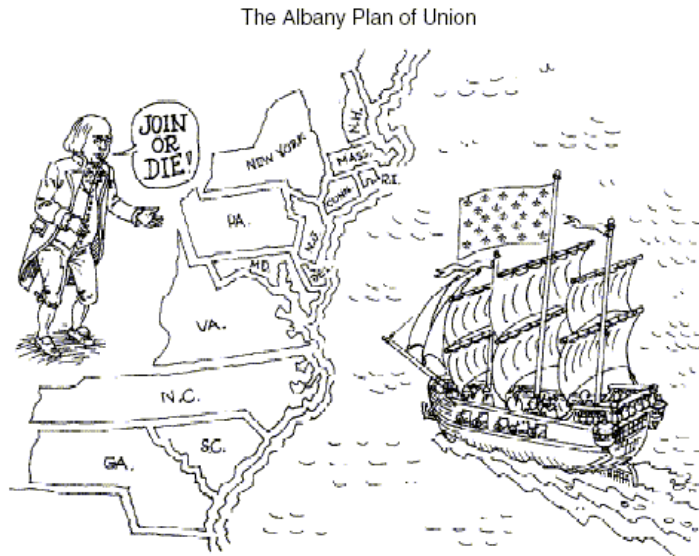
